



West Kendall Baptist Hospital

Fact Sheet

Location: On 30 acres at SW 162 Ave and SW 96th Street, as part of the Kendall Town Center

Hospital: Four-story facility, 282,000 square feet

80 licensed acute care inpatient beds, all private patient rooms; with the capability to add 53 future inpatient beds, with a total capacity of 133 private inpatient beds

Built to withstand a category 5 hurricane

Incorporated Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) standards for environmental responsibility and sustainability

Services: Inpatient care for adult medical and surgical services; including a separate Critical Care Unit

Emergency Services for adults and children, expected to accommodate 40,000 visits annually

Maternity care, including private labor and delivery suites and dedicated c-section operating rooms within the Labor and Delivery unit

Surgical services: four operating rooms, with future expansion capability

Endoscopy suites and future cardiac and vascular procedure rooms

Diagnostic and imaging: CAT scan, MRI, nuclear medicine, X-ray and ultrasound

Medical Office

Building: Free standing, four-story 62,600 square foot facility adjacent to the hospital for physician offices, with an outpatient diagnostic and imaging center on the first floor

Timing: Groundbreaking on September 13, 2008. The new hospital is expected to open in 2011, barring any unforeseen delays

Future

Expansion: Campus is designed to accommodate up to a 300 bed hospital via a new 7-story patient bed tower, clinical chassis expansion, and two elevated parking structures
