



# Baptist Hospital of Miami

## Fact Sheet

**Description:** The 680-bed Baptist Hospital of Miami is part of Baptist Health South Florida, the largest faith-based, not for-profit healthcare organization in the region. Baptist Hospital shares its 82-acre campus with Baptist Children's Hospital, Baptist Cardiac and Vascular Institute and two medical office buildings. Baptist Health also includes South Miami Hospital, Homestead Hospital, Doctors Hospital, Mariners Hospital and Baptist Outpatient Services.

In 2008, there were 31,792 admissions, 78,042 Emergency Center visits and 4,640 births at Baptist Hospital.

Baptist Hospital recently completed construction of the Victor E. Clarke Pavilion, which opened in November, 2008. The four-story building houses the new Emergency Center on the first floor with 100 exam rooms, 20 of which are part of the new Children's Emergency Center. Included are six state-of-the-art trauma rooms (four trauma rooms for adult patients, and two for pediatric patients). The 654,000-square-foot expansion includes a new 120,000-square-foot bed tower with 96 inpatient beds, and a new seven-story parking garage. The second floor of the tower houses the Baptist Hospital Neuroscience Center, an inpatient unit that cares for patients with brain, spine and nervous system injuries or diseases. The fourth floor includes expanded quarters of Baptist Cardiac & Vascular Institute, which has pioneered less invasive techniques to treat heart and circulatory diseases. The Victor E. Clarke Pavilion is named for a local philanthropist and honorary Baptist Health Foundation Board member. His gift of \$10 million led Baptist Health Foundation's campaign to raise funds for the project.

Baptist Hospital employs more than 4,300 people and has a medical staff of more than 1,400 physicians. The comprehensive healthcare services offered at the hospital include: 24-hour emergency care, Children's Emergency Center, Heart Attack Unit and Stroke Team, Family Birth Place, Level II and Level III neonatal intensive care units, Critical Care Center, inpatient and outpatient surgery and outpatient diagnostic and therapeutic services. The hospital's unique features include Baptist Children's Hospital, Baptist Cardiac and Vascular Institute, the Baptist-South Miami Regional Cancer Program, the Neuroscience Center, the Diabetes Care Center, Women's Health Resource Center and the Rehabilitation Center.

**History:** In 1960, when Kendall Drive was just a two-lane dirt road flanked by farms and pastures, a group of dedicated community leaders created Baptist Hospital. Today, the full-service hospital attracts patients from South Florida and the rest of the United States, as well as dozens of countries located throughout the world.
