Description: Homestead Hospital, located at Campbell Drive (SW 312 Street) and SW 147 Avenue, is a 142-bed community hospital that is part of Baptist Health South Florida, the largest not-for-profit healthcare organization in the region. Baptist Health also includes Baptist Hospital, Baptist Children's Hospital, South Miami Hospital, Doctors Hospital, Mariners Hospital, Baptist Cardiac & Vascular Institute and Baptist Outpatient Services.

Homestead Hospital has been a part of the south Miami-Dade community since 1940, when local physician James Archer Smith opened it as a 10-bed hospital east of Krome Avenue. The new \$135 million hospital opened in May 2007, replacing the original facility.

Services: The comprehensive healthcare services offered at Homestead Hospital include acute inpatient care, critical care, outpatient diagnostics, 24-hour emergency, pediatrics, The Birthing Suites, inpatient and outpatient surgery, endoscopy, laboratory and rehabilitation. The hospital's unique features include a 24-hour Children's Emergency Center. Homestead Hospital is accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations.
